## **KK 1 (for children at Kindergarten 1)**

This is a drop off class. The one-hour lesson is structured with a series of fun and short activities. Children learn Mandarin through playing with theme-related toys, Total Physical Response, songs & dance, circle time routine, vocabulary building games, story time, role-play, and arts & crafts. All the activities are conducted in Mandarin only.

8. Yummy food & Refreshing Drinks
